## Our Four Pillars of support expand across the Army, Marine Corps, Navy, & Air Force for Active-Duty, Retired, Veterans, and their immediate family members.

In 2024, the Foundation was thrilled to announce a major expansion to the EODWF's Scholarship program! Thanks to a generous donation recommended by Admiral William H. McRaven, the Foundation can expand and continue its support of Gold Star Children and their educational needs. This generous gift is made possible thanks to the Bezos Courage and Civility Award received by the Admiral from Jeff Bezos and Lauren Sanchez.

In the notification letter, Admiral McRaven said, this gift is being given "owing to the remarkable work being done by the EOD Warrior Foundation in providing education for the children of the fallen".



### I Financial Relief & Grants

The EOD Warrior Foundation Grants provide financial assistance for expenses such as childcare, adaptive equipment, retreats, travel expenses, and debt relief. All active-duty, veteran, and retired EOD Technicians, in addition to wounded, ill, and injured EOD Technicians, family members and family members of the fallen, are eligible to apply. Each grant is decided on a case-by-case basis.

### II Educational Scholarships

As part of our commitment to providing educational assistance, the EODWF annually awards academic scholarships to EOD dependents, with priority given to family members of fallen and wounded warriors. These scholarships are available for undergraduate, advance degrees, and technical schools.

### III Hope & Wellness Programs

The Foundation provides additional support and resources to assist our EOD Warriors and families as they face challenges, changes, and uncertainty in their lives. This network of connections to programs, resources, and EOD specific retreats assist them as they face these challenges, recovery and adjustment to a new life.

### IV Memorial Care

The EODWF is dedicated to honoring the legacy of our fallen EOD Warriors by providing for the maintenance and care of the EOD Memorial Grounds at Eglin Air Force base in Florida. The EOD Memorial honors EOD Warriors who gave their lives in the performance of their duties and the Remembrance Garden & EOD History Path create a lasting tribute to all who have served.

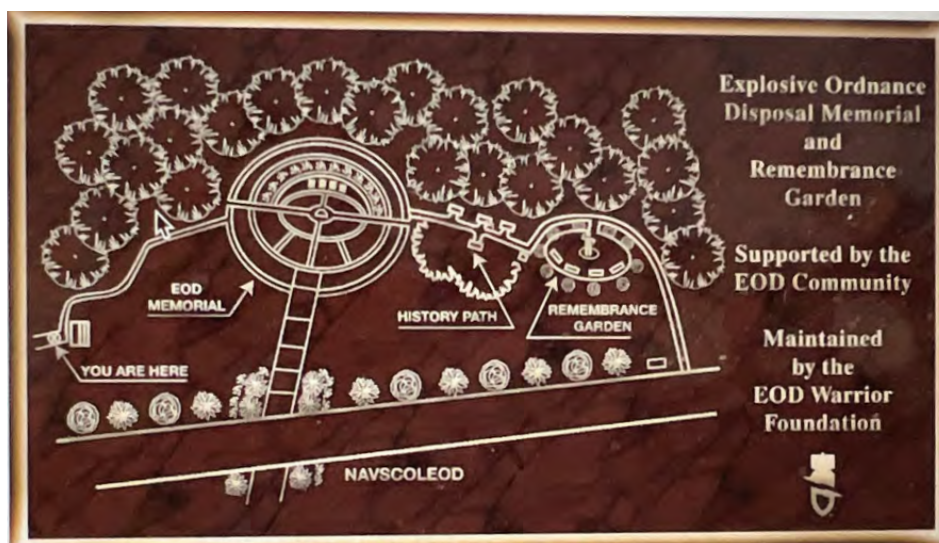

# History Path & EOD Flags

Expanding the EOD Memorial Grounds has long been a vision of the Foundation and the EOD Community. In August 2024, with the help of NAVSCOLEOD, Eglin AFB CE & Staff, Foundation staff, volunteers, and EOD students, we unveiled the EOD History Path—a tribute to our history and sacrifice.

This path, connecting the EOD Memorial to the Remembrance Garden, features four pedestals telling the story of EOD. These pedestals hold the original cenotaphs and nameplates from the 1999 Memorial, preserving the legacy of our fallen. With this addition, we honor those who came before us, while ensuring future generations of EOD Warriors carry forward our tradition of courage, sacrifice, and service.

Thanks to all our amazing volunteers around the world! In 2024, over 2,000 EOD Flags were placed around the US and, for the first time, the Normandy American Cemetery. In addition, over 100 EOD Community Volunteers placed 320+ flower bundles, marking the graves of all EOD Techs in Arlington National Cemetery. A wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown was also laid to honor the 80 Techs classified as MIA or Buried at Sea.
