EOD Warrior Foundation and Volunteers Honor the Fallen at Arlington National Cemetery



As part of the EOD Remembrance Flag program, the EOD Community gathered on Friday and Saturday, October 17 & 18, at Arlington National Cemetery (ANC). There, in respect of ANC's guidelines, over 350+ roses with biodegradable tags were placed on all the known EOD graves located in the cemetery. In addition, a wreath was laid at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier to honor the 80+ EOD Techs listed as MIA, Lost, or Buried at Sea.

The wreath, adorned with a scroll listing the names of those lost and missing, was presented by Hailey and Cole Dayton, the children of EODCS Scott Cooper Dayton, and SSgt Tyler Blattler at MCB Quantico EOD. The wreath placed at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier was the Navy Wreath placed during the EOD Memorial Ceremony in May.

They were joined by over 150+ volunteers, including EOD Techs from Fort Belvoir, Fort Lee, Indian Head, Andrews AFB, Quantico, National Guard, EODMC, O2X, friends, and family. All who visited Arlington that day witnessed a striking display of full dress uniforms and the deep love and respect the EOD Community shares with all who ever wore the badge.



a series of talks surrounding mental health



Mahalo to everyone who joined us for Removing the Stigma – Hawai‘i, an event focused on raising awareness about traumatic brain injury (TBI) and its often unseen effects within the EOD Community. The discussion provided space for open conversation, education, and connection, helping illuminate the physical, psychological, and invisible burdens many of our warriors carry.

Attendees explored the importance of early intervention, recognizing symptoms, and building support systems that understand the unique challenges faced by EOD Technicians and their families. Coming together in this way helps reduce stigma and encourages those affected to seek help sooner.

2025 RAMPART RIDE



Pedals, Purpose, and Record-Breaking Impact: Rampart Ride 2025

Rampart Ride 2025 rolled through Paso Robles with more heart and determination than ever—shattering fundraising records with over **\$70,000** raised for the EOD Warrior Foundation. Hosted once again by the incredible Leon and Cindy Tackitt of Tackitt Family Vineyards, this year's event brought together cyclists from across the country to ride for a mission far deeper than the miles.



From the Friday night welcome party to the final climb on Saturday, riders embraced every moment with grit, humor, and camaraderie. Team Orca Maritime led the charge, raising more than **\$24,000** and delivering unforgettable stories—including a rider who ran the last 8 miles after his bike failed, and another who casually added extra miles “just because.”

Thanks to Tackitt Family Vineyards’ generosity, event expenses stayed under 4%, allowing nearly every dollar raised to directly support EOD Warriors and their families. As Leon shared, “Rampart 2025 was a resounding success... riders stepped up and really rocked the fundraising.”

The celebration continued post-ride with live music, sweeping vineyard views, and a community that showed up in full force to cheer, encourage, and remind riders what this event is truly about.


