With your generosity and support this year, we:

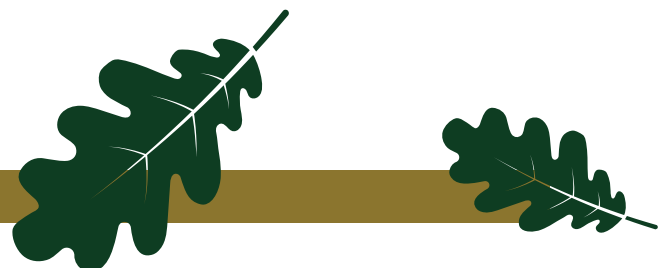
- Provided over **\$230,000** in direct financial relief grants to EOD families in need

In 2024, the EODWF was the proud recipient of a generous gift earmarked for **Scholarships for Gold Star Children**. Thanks to this generous donation recommendation by Admiral William McRaven, the Foundation was able to expand and continue its support of Gold Star Children and their educational needs for the 2025-26 School year. This generous gift is made possible through the Bezos Courage and Civility Award received by the Admiral from Jeff Bezos and Lauren Sánchez Bezos. During the 2025-2026 academic year, the EODWF distributed \$25,000 in scholarships for Gold Star Children—seven undergraduates and two graduate-level students. Scholarship funds support tuition, fees, books, housing, transportation, and technology—critical needs often not covered by other sources.

PILLARS OF SUPPORT

FINANCIAL RELIEF & GRANTS

The EOD Warrior Foundation Grants provide financial assistance for expenses such as childcare, adaptive equipment, retreats, travel expenses, and debt relief. All active-duty, veteran, and retired EOD technicians, in addition to wounded, ill, and injured EOD technicians, family members and family members of the fallen, are eligible to apply. Each grant is decided on a case-by-case basis.

EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

As part of our commitment to providing educational assistance, the EODWF annually awards academic scholarships to EOD dependents, with priority given to family members of fallen and wounded warriors. These scholarships are available to students pursuing undergraduate, postgraduate, and technical school programs



HOPE & WELLNESS PROGRAMS

The Foundation provides additional support and resources to assist our EOD Warriors and families as they face challenges, changes, and uncertainty in their lives. This network of connections to programs, resources, and EOD specific retreats assist them as they face these challenges, recovery and adjustment to a new life.

MEMORIAL CARE

The EODWF is dedicated to honoring the legacy of our fallen EOD Warriors by providing for the maintenance and care of the EOD Memorial Grounds at Eglin Air Force base in Florida. The EOD Memorial honors EOD Warriors who gave their lives in the performance of their duties and the Remembrance Garden creates a lasting tribute to all who have served.





REMOVING THE STIGMA

Thanks to amazing volunteers, speakers, and donors, we are proud to continue the **Removing the Stigma** program for the 5th year.

In December, the program was brought to the Active-Duty and Veteran EOD Community of Hawai'i and beyond.

This event focused on raising awareness about traumatic brain injury (TBI) and its often unseen effects within the EOD Community.

The discussions and community support provided space for open conversation, education, and connection, helping illuminate the physical, psychological, and invisible burdens many of our warriors carry.

Attendees explored the importance of early intervention, recognizing symptoms, and building support systems that understand the unique challenges faced by EOD Technicians and their families. Coming together in this way helps reduce stigma and encourages those affected to seek help sooner.

” I was happy to share my experiences with TBI at the Remove the Stigma event, and doing so also unexpectedly led to personal conversations with many attendees. Over that next week multiple people came up to me, thanked me for speaking, and often shared an experience of their own it reminded them of. Being a conduit for their sharing was humbling. I have also noticed a small shift at work of people accepting my new normal due to their increased understanding of why I care so much about certain things. I thank the EODWF for putting on the event, and continuing to fight to remove the stigma around getting help for our physical and mental wounds”

ANNUAL FLAG PLACEMENTS

Thanks to all our amazing volunteers from around the country! In 2025, over 2,100 EOD Flags were placed around the US. In addition, over 150 EOD Community Volunteers placed 350+ flower bundles, marking the graves of all EOD Techs in Arlington National Cemetery. A wreath, adorned with a scroll listing the names of those missing or buried at sea, was also placed at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. The 2025 Wreath was placed by Hailey and Cole Dayton, the children of EODCS Scott Cooper Dayton, and SSgt Tyler Blattler at MCB Quantico EOD.

This annual event honors all EOD Techs and wouldn't be possible without the amazing support of volunteers in all 50 States and around the world. Thank you for joining with us in remembering all these men and women and honoring them for their service.

O2X

For the first year, we were proud to offer two versions of the O2X Human Performance Workshop! In May, the Active-Duty and Veteran EOD Community participated in a specially designed program with an emphasis on injury prevention, mental health, and support after a military career. In September, EOD Spouses participated in a program with an emphasis on communication, understanding TBIs, and mental health. Both programs also focused on nutrition and the impacts of sleep and fatigue.

The O2X Program is one of the nation's leading subject matter experts across all areas of human performance, including nutrition, fitness, and mental health resilience. Each event was staffed with members of their professional team, and the entire one-day course was customized for those in the EOD Community.

Based on feedback, response, and follow-on comments, the Foundation will be bringing this program to other EOD heavy areas and virtually in 2026.
